Heavy Demolition of the 57,700 sf Yorktown Victory Center

Description:

This was a two-phase project, including the demolition of Welcome Center and the Maintenance Garage. Macsons demolished 57,700 sf of a 3 story Museum, completing the job in 15 weeks, with 4 excavators, and an average 6 man crew. Over 9,500 tons of recycled materials were crushed on site. All brick, block, and concrete were processed to fill the existing site for future use. The project was completed during activities and tours of the new museum and its grounds, less than 100yds away, and without incident. The Museum was soft stripped to allow for over 90% recycling. Two weeks of asbestos abatement prior to demolition included work with pipe insulation and floor tile.
